



# Tiffin Dress and Appearance Regulations

The dress code below applies to all students in Years 7-11. Students in Y12-13 should see their separate Sixth Form dress code.

All students are required to wear school uniform as prescribed by the Governors, whilst in School and whilst travelling to and from School. Stevensons is the supplier of Tiffin School's uniform and PE kit; information is on the [School website](#).

## **ALL UNIFORM AND GAMES KIT MUST BE CLEARLY MARKED WITH THE STUDENT'S NAME.**

### **Valuables**

- The students are responsible for their own belongings in School.
- Valuable items should not be brought to School.
- During PE and Games lessons, valuables (e.g. money/Chromebooks/watches/phones) should be placed in the secure lockers provided in the Sports Hall and at Grist's. You will need to purchase combination padlocks.

### **Blazers**

- Students in Years 7, 8 & 9 wear the Tiffin Venetian Striped blazer.
- Students in Year 10 and 11 wear a Tiffin navy blue blazer.
- The blazer must be worn everyday, including with PE kit.

**Shirts:** Plain white, these may be long or short sleeved.

**Ties:** A school or House tie must be worn for School, correctly tied at the collar.

**Trousers:** Long, dark charcoal grey. Plain black belts (without oversized buckles or logos) only.

**Jumpers:** If a jumper is worn, this must be the Tiffin branded jumper available from Stevensons.

**Footwear:** Black leather shoes; trainers are not permitted. Any shoes containing logos or branding are considered trainers and are not permitted.

**Socks:** Dark blue, dark grey or black.

**Outdoor Coats:** Plain coloured, preferably dark. Coats with large emblems, motifs or writing may not be worn. Hoodies may not be worn. Coats may not be worn in place of a school blazer.

**Hair:** Exaggerated styles are not permitted, such as dyed or bleached hair, and shaved patterns in hair. Long hair must be tied back. This is not a comprehensive list and, if in doubt, parents and students should consult the school beforehand. Students may be sent home to have their hair changed if these regulations are breached.

**Jewellery:** Students are not permitted to wear jewellery including earrings and religious symbols/necklaces/bracelets. Students are not permitted to wear make-up.

**Badges:** Badges of outside organisations are not permitted. Badges representing awards/school responsibilities may be worn, subject to the Head's approval.

### **PE and Games Kit:**

- Correct Tiffin branded kit must be worn.
  - school tracksuit trousers or white school PE shorts/blue school PE shorts
  - trainers
  - school PE top
  - school mid-layer (school tracksuit top)
- PE uniform should *not* consist of the following items:
  - Tour tops / tops from training camps.
  - Match kit only to be worn on match days.
- PE uniform may be worn on days on which students have any of the following school activities:
  - Games (Year 7: Fri; Year 8: Tues; Year 9: Mon; Year 10: Thurs; Year 11: Wed).
  - A school sports match.
  - A PE or Dance lesson).
  - A sports club before school, at lunchtime or after school.
- On all other days, formal uniform should be worn.

**The school blazer must be worn with the PE kit**, in the same way as the blazer is worn with formal uniform. The school blazer should be worn over either the PE top or the PE mid-layer (school tracksuit top).

### **Specialist Clothing:**

- Students riding cycles to School should conform to safety precautions which recommend the wearing of light-reflecting objects.
- Cyclists must wear helmets.
- Students will be expected to wear the necessary protective equipment and clothing as specified by the various Departmental Heads of practical subjects at the beginning of each academic year.
- Students should have a laboratory/art coat.

### **Equipment:**

- Students must have a suitable school bag for exercise books, text books and Chromebook.
- A separate bag is recommended for PE and Games kit.

### **Hats:**

- Hats are not permitted to be worn at school without gaining permission from the Head of Year.
- Students may not wear caps at school. During extreme summer weather, protective headwear may be worn if a member of the Senior Leadership team gives formal notice.
- Winter knitted/beanie hats may be worn outside during cold weather. They must be unbranded or Tiffin branded.

We are aware of forthcoming changes to legislation in relation to school uniform and will be updating our policy to reduce the number of branded or distinctive items in time for September 2026.
