

Tiffin School Admission Appeals Timetable 2026/27

For entry to Year 7 in September 2026

2 March 2026 - National Offer Day

Your local authority will inform you of the outcome of your application for a secondary school place after 5.00 pm on 2 March 2026. (Please be aware that this is the start of a period when offers are made and that further offers of secondary school places are made in the coming months.)

If a parent or guardian wishes to appeal against the decision not to offer their child a place at Tiffin School, they should email Year7admissions@tiffin.kingston.sch.uk stating their child's full name and date of birth.

31 March 2026

Appeal forms must be lodged with Surrey County Council Appeals Service (which organises the appeals for Tiffin School) by 31st March 2026.

Appellants will be sent notification of their appeal hearing at least 10 clear school days in advance of the hearing.

The Governors' written statement and appellant's appeal form will be sent to all parties (appellants, the school, panel members, and clerk to the panel) at least 7 working days before the appeal hearing.

Having received the papers, the appellants and the school have the opportunity to present any additional evidence. Any additional evidence must be received no later than 5:00 pm on the day notified in the letter with details of the appeal hearing. If received after that date, the additional evidence may not be considered at the appeal hearing.

16 June 2026

The Appeal Panel aims to hear appeals for Tiffin School by 16 June 2026 (40 school days).

Appeal Timetable for all other applications (Years 8 to 13)

The process is similar for applications to all year groups - If a parent or guardian wishes to appeal against the decision not to offer their child a place at Tiffin School, they should email Year7admissions@tiffin.kingston.sch.uk stating their son's full name and date of birth and their year group. An appeal will be heard within 30 school days of an appeal being lodged. The School Governors' statement and appellant's appeal forms will be sent to all parties (appellants, the school, panel members and clerk to the panel) at least 10 clear school days in advance of the appeal hearing. Having received the papers, the appellants and the school have an opportunity to present additional evidence, but that additional evidence must be received no later than 5:00pm on the day notified in the letter with details of the appeal hearing. If received after that date, the additional evidence or information may not be considered at the appeal hearing.
