

SEN, Disabilities Access Arrangements

If your child has special educational needs or a disability that may require additional access arrangements for the 11+ tests, **we strongly recommend you register as soon as possible** so you and your son's primary school can provide the evidence of his needs as soon as possible.

We also strongly recommend that you provide all information from your child's primary school **no later than Friday, 17th July 2026**. After this date, schools will be closed for the summer, so it may be very difficult for you to get all the information needed by the final deadline of 1st September.

We cannot guarantee access arrangements can be put in place unless we have all the documentation we need.

If your child has an EHCP, there are separate processes for school admissions to be followed, and you should speak first with your Local Authority, who administer the process. You still need to complete the online Registration Form for your child to be able to sit the Tiffin School Entrance Tests. Your child will still need to meet the entrance criteria as set out in our Admissions Policy to be considered for a place at Tiffin School.

If you wish us to consider putting Access Arrangements in place for the tests, you need to submit supporting evidence. We also need evidence from your child's Primary School SENCO, using the form you can download and send to them as part of your registration.
